- When communion is taken the elements will be prepared beforehand, in a hygienic way, into individual disposable cups with lids that attenders can collect on the way into the building. They can be disposed of into pedal bin on the way out.
- There will be no shared materials (Bibles, newsletters etc.).
- Parents/Guardians who attend will be advised they need to supervise their children at all times and they are not allowed to roam around. The grassed space to the front of the church will be available for parents to take their children to if needed.
- We will communicate that no social interaction should take place without social distancing.
- Posters will be displayed in the entrance area with hand sanitisation guidance.
- A cleaning schedule will be made available and kept
